Holiday Food Requests

Believe it or not, the holidays are right around the corner and we will soon start preparing to distribute close to 200 holiday food baskets to families in need. This means we need your donations! Please keep in mind that although we have specific requests for the holiday baskets, we appreciate all food donations. Additional items will be distributed through our regular food pantry, which operates year-round. Items we need specifically for the holiday baskets include:

10-12 lb turkeys, stuffing, canned soups, canned fruits & vegetables, canned cranberry sauce, rice, dry beans, bread mixes, white & sweet potatoes, gravy, fresh fruit, and dessert mixes.

Additional items we need throughout the year include:

peanut butter, jelly, macaroni and cheese, spaghetti and other pasta, spaghetti sauce, tuna, canned meat, single serving food, granola bars, trail mix, canned pasta, ramen noodles, instant oatmeal, and cereal.

School Supplies Program Gets an A+

Our School Supplies Program took place the week before school started, on August 26 and 27 and distributed over \$8000 of supplies to students in need. We had a line of at least twenty people when our doors opened at 9:00 Monday morning and we kept going strong until we closed at 3:00 that afternoon. A group of 8 volunteers, including Ashley McLeod and her youth group, Pat Pennington and her granddaughter, and board member, Joe Morgan, worked hard to keep supplies going out the door. By the end of the day 358 backpacks full of supplies had been distributed! The remainder were prepared for distribution the following morning when the Director, Alicia Mathews, handed out the last 25 backpacks and continued to distribute until all supplies were gone about 20 minutes later. In all, 401 students were assisted in a distribution that averaged over one backpack handed out per minute!

This program distributed more supplies than ever before, a total of 383 backpacks and enough supplies for over 400 students to have a great start to their school year. None of this would have been possible without the support of the many churches and individuals that donated school supplies, our anonymous donor that provided the funds to purchase backpacks and additional supplies, and the kindness of the folks at Lafayette Presbyterian Church for allowing us to use their church as a distribution site. The people involved directly with this program, volunteers, staff, board, and Bonnie and Bruce at Lafayette Presebyterian Church made this year a huge success! We are so grateful for everything they did to help us help students in need in our community!
